To Christians of all dominations,

On November 5th of this year, Bishop Anthony B. Taylor of Little Rock introduced a pastoral letter titled “I Was a Stranger and You Welcomed Me...” to the Catholic Church and to the public. The purpose of this letter is to portray illegal immigration as a Christian right and to indoctrinate Christians into supporting illegal immigration.

First and foremost, Christians are to lead others to the Lord. *Mark 16:15 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to the whole creation.* The Church also has an obligation to help the poor. *Luke 14:13 But when you give a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind.* Preaching the gospel is to be done to anybody from the free to prisoners. Things such as food pantries and soup kitchens can be made available to whomever a church chooses.

Christians also have right and an obligation to be involved with political issues. While pastors and churches can't officially endorse a candidate, they can encourage their congregations to lobby for or against certain legislation. The 501C laws that are designed to stop non-profits from engaging in politics are almost never enforced on leftist organizations. Christians have both a right and obligation to be involved in the politics of the United States of America. The 2008 election placed into power many people who do not have good records in dealing with issues from a Christian perspective. It will take the help of Christians to lobby about issues such as abortion, taxes, homosexual marriage, and the free exercise of religion. Christians appear to have shown an understanding of these issues. Christians recently helped pass Proposition 8 in California, which overturned the legalization of homosexual marriage by the leftist courts. Christians once again followed Biblical principle despite legal threats from anti-Christian groups such as the American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU).

However on the issue of illegal immigration, many Christians are confused about what to do as individuals, as a church, and as a nation. Most of the confusion centers on the difference between legal immigrants and illegal aliens. When legal immigrants and illegal aliens are mixed together, it makes it difficult to decide what rights illegal aliens have or what obligations the US taxpayers have in helping illegal aliens. Illegal immigration and legal immigration are two different issues. Legal immigration is a system that can benefit America and other countries but only if it can be controlled. America is not obligated or able to accept every poor person from every country and Christians should not make any such demand. The current legal immigration system is over burdened and needs reform, not more applicants. Immigration Laws are justified and need to be enforced, not ignored. Christians should instead focus more on demanding reform in 3rd World Nations.

Illegal immigration is the source of evils such as identity theft, welfare fraud, illegal housing, illegal driving, drug smuggling, rape, murder, child prostitution, and terrorism. It is a system similar to slavery in that it is an evil that is not needed by our economy. It is destructive to the citizens of United States of America, legal immigrants, and millions of citizens living in corrupt 3rd world countries. Support for illegal immigration is not loving the Lord or loving thy neighbor.

Christians should lobby for laws that reduce illegal immigration such as Oklahoma Bill HB1804, which reduced illegal immigration throughout the entire state. As a result of HB 1804, Oklahoma has the lowest unemployment rate in the nation. Christians can also fight for ballot initiatives such as the Secure Arkansas Petition, which would have required proof of citizenship in order to obtain state benefits. When laws that reward illegal aliens are proposed, such as HB1525, which would have given in-state tuition to illegal alien students, Christians can join other concerned citizens in stopping such proposals. The 15-20 million illegal aliens in the U.S. are criminals. Just as Christians in the United States fought to end slavery and child labor, we can solve illegal immigration through attrition and enforcement and we are justified in doing so. Below are recommendations on how Christians can stop illegal immigration.

- Ask God for wisdom and guidance on this and all other issues.
- Pray for an end to government corruption in nations abroad and here. Corruption is the #1 cause of the poverty which causes people to immigrate.
- Fight against government corruption. Christians can speak up, write, protest at Consulates, or lobby their elected officials.
- Educate one another on the immigration issue. Don't take the word of the mainstream media or leftist organizations.
- Demand that Churches not be used as sanctuaries for illegal aliens.
- Lobby for bills that reduce illegal immigration such as bills that require proof of citizenship for benefits. You can email, call, fax or talk to leaders in person
- Lobby against bills that support illegal immigration
- Make sure that programs that help legal immigrants both inside and outside the Church are used to help legal immigrants become US citizens.
- Make sure that programs that help the poor do not enable criminal activity or further sinful acts
- Join organizations that oppose illegal immigration on a national and local level
- Do not associate with organizations that advocate criminal and sinful acts such as ACORN or La Raza
- Have your church add recommendations such as these to it's governing law to avoid confusion on how to deal with this issue

Christian Doctrine on Illegal Immigration

The History of Immigration

Immigration is an issue that has been with man since the beginning. *Genesis 3:23-24 therefore the LORD God sent him out from the Garden of Eden, to cultivate the ground from which he was taken. So He drove the man out; and at the east of the garden of Eden He stationed the cherubim and the flaming sword which turned every direction to guard the way to the tree of life.* God's chosen people have had to immigrate several times. Bishop Taylor's letter cites Abraham leaving the city of Ur for The Promised Land, Joseph having his brothers relocated to Egypt, the Exodus from Egypt, the return to Israel from Babylon, and the scattering of the Jewish people among the nations as reasons why we should have no limits on immigration. In almost these examples, the law itself was followed. Canaan had no immigration laws during Abraham's time. Joseph had the authority to have his family immigrate to Egypt. *Genesis 42:6 And Pharaoh said to Joseph, "See, I have set you over all the land of Egypt."* The return from Babylon was also within the law. *2 Chronicles 36:23 Thus says Cyrus king of Persia: The LORD, the God of heaven, has given me all the kingdoms of the earth, and he has charged me to build him a house at Jerusalem, which is in Judah. Whoever is among you of all his people, may his God be with him, and let him go up to Jerusalem, which is in Judah, and rebuild the house of the LORD, the God of Israel.*

The only exception where the law of man was broken when God's people were immigrating was the Exodus from Egypt. In that instance, God directly overruled the Pharaoh with plagues and the miracle at the Red Sea. *Exodus 13:14 And in the future, your children will ask you, 'What does all this mean?' Then you will tell them, 'With the power of his mighty hand, the Lord brought us out of Egypt, the place of our slavery* While the people of Israel eventually settled down, they established a nation with borders. They were also warned about defending their nation's borders and their culture. *Exodus 23:31-33 I will establish your borders from the Red Sea to the Sea of the Philistines, and from the desert to the River. I will hand over to you the people who live in the land and you will drive them out before you. Do not make a covenant with them or with their gods. Do not let them live in your land, or they will cause you to sin against me, because the worship of their gods will certainly be a snare to you.*

Immigration to the US

Today, mass immigration generally occurs when living conditions become so bad in a country that the population is forced to leave to a better country. Immigration to the United States of America has occurred for many reasons. During the 1800's immigrants from Europe came due to famine and war. Events such as the Irish Potato Famine resulted in a mass immigration that lasted well into the 20th Century. Fortunately, the USA was able to assimilate these immigrants into the general population. Equally important, the countries in Europe eventually reformed and turned into successful nations. When America accepts a certain number poor from other nations in an orderly fashion, it can be a great benefit to the USA. Immigration can also be a short term benefit to the other nations who are unable to provide basic civilization to its population.

US Citizens are able to benefit from new ideas and hard work from immigrants and the immigrants themselves are allowed to better their lives and the lives of their children. However, if too much mass immigration occurs, it can become harmful to all countries and to their people. This is exactly the situation between the USA and Mexico. Just like any other country, the USA has a limited amount of resources and opportunities for the population inside its borders. Beyond that number, systems that are needed by immigrants and citizens alike become more expensive or shut down. Taxpayer-funded Government programs, which are supposed to provide a temporary help to those in need lose revenue. This results in higher taxes for citizens. The American taxpayers, most of whom are descendents of those immigrated here before, are neither willing nor able to provide a living for the poor around the world. Countries like Mexico should reform just like those in Europe.

Illegal immigration

The USA was founded by people who made the place they lived in the best nation in the world. Despite what pro-illegal alien advocates claim, there is no justification of illegal immigration in The Declaration of Independence, which was a letter from American Colonist to the corrupt and oppressive British Regime. American Colonist did not use The Declaration of Independence as a means to immigrate to another country; they used it to demand reform where they lived. "That to secure these rights (Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness); Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed..." If the only God-given right of Hispanics living in 3rd world countries is to leave, can Bishop Taylor state what the Mexican government is instituted for? Immigration laws are not immoral, racist, xenophobic or unjust. They are there for several reasons. The attempt by pro-illegal alien activist to compare immigration laws to Jim Crow laws is an insult to the Civil Rights movement. The reality is that illegal immigration harms African Americans the most as illegals steal jobs and social benefits from them. A perfect example is the immigration raid in Laurel, MS. Over 600 illegal aliens were detained at the Howard Industries electrical plant, a company that received 31.5 Million in 2002 from the state to expand. Within hours of the raid, hundreds of African Americans were at the plant filling out job applications. ICE did more to help African Americans than any welfare program from a liberal politician or crooked housing deals from ACORN. The recent downturn in the US economy is in large part to an effort by Freddie Mae and Freddie Mac to give mortgages to illegal aliens. Freddie and Fannie, Government run organizations, allowed illegals to obtain loans w/out the need of Social Security # or even a driver's license. Illegal aliens were allowed to use Individual Taxpayer Identification Numbers (ITIN) instead. Organizations like Freddie Mae, Freddie Mac, and ACORN then forced banks to distribute these loans under threats of lawsuit and boycott. Illegal aliens in the construction industry also contributed to the decline in the housing economy.

Issues talked about in the Bible

Although it is not the most popular issue mentioned, immigration is talked about in the Bible. *Leviticus 24:22. The Lord said, "You are to have the same law for the alien and the native-born". Numbers 15:15. The community is to have the same rules for you and*

for the alien living among you. John 10:1 Jesus said, "the man who does not enter the sheep pen by the gate, but climbs in some other way, is a thief and a robber."

Taxes

Matthew 22:14-17 And they came up and said to Him, Teacher, we know that You are sincere and what You profess to be, that You cannot lie, and that You have no personal bias for anyone; for You are not influenced by partiality and have no regard for anyone's external condition or position, but in truth You teach the way of God. Is it lawful to give tribute to Caesar or not? Should we pay or should we not pay? But knowing their hypocrisy, He asked them, why do you put me to the test? Bring me a coin (a denarius), so I may see it. And they brought Him one. Then He asked them, whose image (picture) is this? And whose superscription (title)? They said to Him, Caesar's. Jesus said to them, Pay to Caesar the things that are Caesar's and to God the things that are God's. And they stood marveling and greatly amazed at Him. Romans 13:5-8 Therefore one must be subject, not only to avoid God's wrath and escape punishment, but also as a matter of principle and for the sake of conscience. For this same reason you pay taxes, for the civil authorities are official servants under God, devoting themselves to attending to this very service. 7Render to all men their dues. Pay taxes to whom taxes are due, revenue to whom revenue is due, respect to whom respect is due, and honor to whom honor is due. 8Keep out of debt and owe no man anything, except to love one another; for he who loves his neighbor has fulfilled the Law.

Matthew 17:24-27 When they arrived in Capernaum, the collectors of the half shekel [the temple tax] went up to Peter and said, Does not your Teacher pay the half shekel? He answered, Yes. And when he came home, Jesus spoke to him first, saying, what do you think, Simon? From whom do earthly rulers collect duties or tribute--from their own sons or from others not of their own family? And when Peter said, from other people not of their own family, Jesus said to him, then the sons are exempt. However, in order not to give offense and cause them to stumble [that is, to cause them to judge unfavorably and unjustly] go down to the sea and throw in a hook. Take the first fish that comes up, and when you open its mouth you will find there a shekel. Take it and give it to them to pay the temple tax for me and for yourself.

US citizens are required to pay sales and income tax. Many illegals only pay sales tax and are hired by businesses for the purpose of paying their share of the taxes. US Taxpayer money is supposed to pay for government services to US Citizens. Instead, millions of taxpayer dollars go to people who should not even be in the country. Hillary used the Sunday school story character The Good Samaritan in her statement about Christians and illegals. Hillary, along with many illegal immigrant advocates fails to realize that the Samaritan did not use someone else's money to take care of the robbery victim, but his own. *Luke 10:33-35 But a Samaritan, as he traveled, came where the man was; and when he saw him, he took pity on him. He went to him and bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine. Then he put the man on his own donkey, took him to an inn and took care of him. The next day he took out two silver coins and gave them to the innkeeper. 'Look after him,' he said, 'and when I return, I will reimburse you for any extra expense you may have.*

Citizenship

Acts 22:25-29 As they tied Paul down to lash him, Paul said to the officer standing there, "Is it legal for you to whip a Roman citizen who hasn't even been tried? "The officer went to the commander and asked, "What are you doing? This man is a Roman citizen!" So the commander went over and asked Paul, "Tell me, are you a Roman citizen?" "Yes, I certainly am," Paul replied. "I am, too," the commander muttered, "and it cost me plenty!" "But I am a citizen by birth!" The soldiers who were about to interrogate Paul quickly withdrew when they heard he was a Roman citizen, and the commander was frightened because he had ordered him bound and whipped. Ephesians 2-19 So now you Gentiles are no longer strangers and foreigners. You are citizens along with all of God's holy people. You are members of God's family.

Being an illegal immigrant is just becoming better than being Citizen of the United States of America. In some states, such as Kansas, illegals can get in-state tuition for college that is not available to US citizens going to another state. There are also several taxpayer funded programs that are available to illegals that are not available to US Citizens. Citizenship is supposed to be a great honor. Legal immigrants work hard to learn English and study our constitution to become US Citizens. Many legal immigrants risk death by joining the military in order to become citizens. The illegal immigrant agenda wants to cheat this honor with backdoor deals and amnesties. Even the right to live in heaven is described as "citizenship"

Government Corruption

Deuteronomy 16:19: Do not pervert justice or show partiality. Do not accept a bribe, for a bribe blinds the eyes of the wise and twists the words of the righteous. 1 Samuel 8:3 But his sons did not walk in his ways. They turned aside after dishonest gain and accepted bribes and perverted justice. Proverbs 17:23 A wicked man accepts a bribe in secret to pervert the course of justice. Acts 24:26 Several days later Felix came with his wife Drusilla, who was a Jewess. He sent for Paul and listened to him as he spoke about faith in Christ Jesus. As Paul discoursed on righteousness, self-control and the judgment to come, Felix was afraid and said, "That's enough for now! You may leave. When I find it convenient, I will send for you." At the same time he was hoping that Paul would offer him a bribe, so he sent for him frequently and talked with him. When two years had passed, Felix was succeeded by Porcius Festus, but because Felix wanted to grant a favor to the Jews, he left Paul in prison. Daniel 6:4 At this, the administrators and the satraps tried to find grounds for charges against Daniel in his conduct of government affairs, but they were unable to do so. They could find no corruption in him, because he was trustworthy and neither corrupt nor negligent. Matthew 23:1-4 Then Jesus said to the crowds and to his disciples: "The teachers of the law and the Pharisees sit in Moses' seat. So you must obey them and do everything they tell you. But do not do what they do, for they do not practice what they preach. They tie up heavy loads and put them on men's shoulders, but they themselves are not willing to lift a finger to move them. Luke 2:46 Jesus replied, "And you experts in the law, woe to you, because you load people down with burdens they can hardly carry, and you yourselves will not lift one finger to help them.

While pro-illegal immigrant Christians claim to help illegal immigrants, they do nothing to stop the cause of the suffering; corruption. The Mexican Government is well known for its corruption and negligence toward its people. When the Negligent Narco Regime of Mexico ignored hundreds of murders in Juarez, we heard virtually nothing from these Christian organizations that claim to help Hispanics. Nor do we hear any demand that the Mexican Government pay for housing, healthcare, education, and other necessities that the Mexican government is supposed to provide Mexicans. That burden has been put upon the American taxpayer thanks to Hispanic activist groups such as the lawyers of MALDEF. These Christian organizations could also put pressure on corrupt businesses such as Tyson Foods to stop hiring illegals and breaking US law, instead they help corrupt businesses by helping the trafficking of illegals. Helping illegal immigration also helps the human/drug trafficking business, which enslaves and abuses the neglected citizens of other countries. South Africans were not helped during the Clinton Administration by bringing them to the US for cheap labor; they were helped by the ending of the Apartheid Government. The same is true with those living under Communism. People such as Ronald Reagan and Pope John Paul II helped those in Eastern Europe and the USSR by standing up to Communist Regimes. In the 1930s, Bishop Rafael Guizar of Valencia stood up to a corrupt Mexican Regime. Sadly, it appears many Catholics have not followed his example.

“helping the poor”

Matthew 23:5-7 "Everything they(Pharisees) do is done for men to see: They make their phylacteries[a] wide and the tassels on their garments long; they love the place of honor at banquets and the most important seats in the synagogues; they love to be greeted in the marketplaces and to have men call them 'Rabbi.' John 12:3-8 Then Mary took about a pint[a] of pure nard, an expensive perfume; she poured it on Jesus' feet and wiped his feet with her hair. And the house was filled with the fragrance of the perfume. 4But one of his disciples, Judas Iscariot, who was later to betray him, objected, "Why wasn't this perfume sold and the money given to the poor? It was worth a year's wages." He did not say this because he cared about the poor but because he was a thief; as keeper of the money bag, he used to help himself to what was put into it. "Leave her alone," Jesus replied. "It was intended that she should save this perfume for the day of my burial. 8You will always have the poor among you, but you will not always have me." Peter 4 :14If you are insulted because of the name of Christ, you are blessed, for the Spirit of glory and of God rests on you. If you suffer, it should not be as a murderer or thief or any other kind of criminal, or even as a meddler. 16However, if you suffer as a Christian, do not be ashamed, but praise God that you bear that name.

There are verses in the Bible that deal with many of the “bleeding heart types” that twist the act of helping the poor into their own agenda. Many people “help the poor” to make an effort to draw attention to themselves. Many in the illegal immigration agenda claim to help the poor so that they can advance the ideas of multiculturalism, “Aztlán”, socialist equality, and similar agendas. To criticize their agenda is portrayed as being “mean” to those in poverty. There are also those who think that it’s OK to break the law if you are “helping the poor”, the Bible states otherwise.

Negligence

Exodus 21:28-29 "If a bull gores a man or a woman to death, the bull must be stoned to death, and its meat must not be eaten. But the owner of the bull will not be held responsible. If, however, the bull has had the habit of goring and the owner has been warned but has not kept it penned up and it kills a man or woman, the bull must be stoned and the owner also must be put to death. 2 Chronicles 29:8-11 Therefore, the anger of the LORD has fallen on Judah and Jerusalem; he has made them an object of dread and horror and scorn, as you can see with your own eyes. This is why our fathers have fallen by the sword and why our sons and daughters and our wives are in captivity. Now I intend to make a covenant with the LORD, the God of Israel, so that his fierce anger will turn away from us. My sons, do not be negligent now, for the LORD has chosen you to stand before him and serve him, to minister before him and to burn incense."

Many of those who enter this country illegally are criminals, diseased, and even terrorist. What will be the excuse if one of the illegals being housed in a church becomes the next Denver Cop Killer? If activist help some illegals crossing the border, who turn out to have the bird flu, will the activists not be partially responsible for the negligent homicide of 1,000's? Being Christian does not mean giving food, clothing, and shelter from the law to the next Mohammed Atta. When illegal immigrants cause harm in the US, those who help them share some of the blame.

Churches should not advocate breaking or eliminating laws that protect this nation. Nor should churches provide sanctuary to criminals. If an illegal alien can be justified in their crimes because they are poor, minorities with children, then so can a car thief, shoplifter, bank robber etc. It is our belief that The Church should advocate for ending illegal immigration in the US by attrition and enforcement and that demand the reform of 3rd world countries.

Appendix II

Fact sheet about Illegal Immigration

Illegal Immigration in Arkansas

Arkansas requested \$451,000 from the federal government in 1999 for the incarceration of illegal aliens in state and local jails and prisons. They received only \$174,000, leaving Arkansas taxpayers to pay the remaining \$277,000. Currently, Arkansas pays \$117 million for illegals. By 2010, it will be \$202 million and by 2020, it will be \$356 million if a guest worker law is passed.

The Little Rock now has a Mexican Consulate, which will be used to provide services for illegals and lobby the state government to provide services for illegals. AR laws: ANN 6-52-101 Code 22-2-114© (i) Ark. Code 22-5-401(b) and Ark. Code 22-2-108 were violated by the state in creating this consulate.

In Springdale, schools are so crowded that hundreds of students are being bused to campuses outside their neighborhoods. Plans to add an elementary school every 2 years from now, which will cost millions, won't be enough to handle population growth.

Tyson Foods was supposed to go on trial in March of '08 for cheating legal workers and hiring illegals. Here's how much some of their Key Execs made in '06: John H. Tyson-Chairman 1.17M, Richard L. Bond-CEO, 1.14M, James V. Lochner-Senior Group VP 526K. Tyson Foods is now part of the Arkansas Friendship Coalition, a pro illegal immigration lobbying group that includes the ACLU

AR courts and police departments spent \$14.7 million on immigrants in 2004, while the state Department of Correction spent \$1.8 million on illegal immigrants last year. The majority of Meth in Arkansas, as well as the US, is made in Mexico and smuggled into the United States

Oklahoma, Missouri, and Tennessee recently passed laws that force illegals out of their states by attrition and enforcement. OK's law just went into effect 11/1/07 despite lawsuits from pro-illegals

While Pulaski County needed a new prison, and our education system was under budget, the Mexican Consulate was given rent at the AR Rehab Services building at a cost of \$1 per year. At least \$60,000 of AR taxpayer funds went to the \$1.2 million building project for the Consulate

A study done by US Representative Steve King of Iowa showed that 12 Americans are murdered daily by illegal aliens and 13 are killed by drunk illegal alien drivers, making an annual death toll of 4,745. More Americans are killed by Mexico's sponsoring of illegal immigration than by Iran's sponsoring of terrorism. More of those deaths will occur in Arkansas.

Corruption in Mexico

- Over 600 gruesome murders of women have gone unsolved in Juarez, Mexico
- In Mexico City, 80% percent of crimes go unreported because the inept and corrupt police
- Border-towns like Nuevo Laredo have become official war-zones
- Communist revolts have festered in the states of Chiapas and Oaxaca
- Taxpayer aided illegal aliens in America sent \$20 billion to Mexico in annual remittances in 2005
- Monopoly Tycoon Carlos Slim now controls 90% of Mexico's telephone lines and has become the second richest man in the world. Not one multi-million dollar monopoly has been broken up by the Mexican Government
- 10 out of 26 Latin American billionaires live in Mexico
- \$2.3 billion goes to bribing officials, with the poorest paying 14% of their income in bribes.

- Vamos Mexico, a charity founded by Fox's wife Martha Sahagun, spent less than 35% of its income on charity and is under investigation for illegal gambling funds and other diverted funds
- Unemployment in Mexico is 40%, and there are virtually no welfare benefits to provide the basics for poverty-stricken families in Mexico
